Re: Weather related school closing or delayed start

You will receive a phone call by 5:30AM informing you of either a delayed start or school cancellation for the day. The following information will guide you to what will happen in the event of a delayed start of a school day.

If “NO SCHOOL” is announced that indicates that all Reed-Custer schools are not in session. We will not provide transportation to any school, even if that school (i.e. SOWIC, WILCO, Special Ed) is in session. SOWIC ELS at the intermediate school will not be in session. Unless we tell you otherwise events that were scheduled after school such as sports, field trips, etc will also be cancelled.

If “DELAYED START” is announced the buses that pickup MS and HS students will not run at their normal time. The PS and IS students WILL be picked up at their NORMAL times and both of these buildings will start as normal including the ELS program housed at RCIS. The MS and HS students will be picked up AFTER the elementary students with their pickup times being somewhere between 8:40 and 9:25AM. Classes will begin at 9:30AM and the modified schedule for each building is included below. Special education buses will attempt to run normal bus schedules. Unless the weather becomes worse or road conditions deteriorate during the day, all schools will be dismissed at normal times and after school activities will be as scheduled.

Thank you for your cooperation and, as always, make sure your home and cell phone numbers are updated in PowerSchool at the building your student(s) attend. Thank you for your cooperation.
