Each of the four Reed-Custer buildings individualized their needs in the areas of BE RESPECTFUL, BE RESPONSIBLE, BE A ROLE MODEL and came up with a behavior chart specific to each school.

The chart breaks down what is expected of the students in each area of the school. (CLASSROOM, CAFETERIA, HALLWAY, ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL TO BUSES, BUSES, and BATHROOMS).

Posters were made and posted in each of the designated areas. The design/logo was created at the high school, by the art department.

At the start of the RCMS school year, the classroom teachers introduced and explained these expectations to the students. The Panther Time Teachers went over the classroom, hallway, and bathroom poster specifics with the students. Mr. Young discussed the cafeteria and arrival / dismissal posters with the kids during the lunch rotations. Students will know what is expected of them. Students will learn and practice expected behaviors in all locations.

Students, who take responsibility to behave positively, will be recognized with "ACE Tickets." Staff members will present "ACE Tickets" to students who demonstrate the positive behaviors listed on the chart. A double ticket roll will be used for this purpose. One ticket will be placed in the "Drum" with the students name on it, while the other ticket will be given to the student.

The "ACE Tickets" will be entered into a monthly, school wide drawing to determine 5 winners. These "ACE Award" winners will receive prizes and will also be publicized in the local media.
